



## 4U2 Program

Enjoy expert advice and installation of energy-saving improvements to reduce your energy costs and maintain comfort ... all for an affordable, one-time co-pay. The **4U2 Program** is all about YOU!

### How It Works

- Eligible Minnesota Energy Resources customers can fill out the attached application, or go to [minnesotaenergyresources.com](http://minnesotaenergyresources.com) to print out an application form.
- Send in your application and one of the three forms of income verification required (pay stubs from previous three months, unemployment statement and verification of unemployment, or copy of last year's tax return).
- If you qualify, we will call to schedule a 4U2 In-Home Audit with one of our energy advisors. If you don't, we will call you to let you know and suggest an alternative program.
- During your home evaluation, our energy advisor will identify potential energy improvements that Minnesota Energy Resources will cover. These could include attic and wall insulation to keep your

home warm in the winter and cool in the summer; air sealing to reduce drafts; and replacing your furnace if it's not running efficiently. These improvements will make your home more comfortable and energy efficient.

- Minnesota Energy Resources will work with qualified contractors and invest in your home to make it more comfortable, affordable, healthier and energy efficient. We will cover the installation costs of every cost-effective measure identified during the audit. If it calls for insulation, we will work with contractors to install it. Furnace system old and inefficient? We will tune it up or replace it if it is eligible.
- If cost-effective energy-efficiency measures are identified and installed in your home, a one-time co-pay of \$150 may be added to your bill.
- The 4U2 program does not assist with paying energy bills, but rather helps lower future energy costs.

### Qualifications (you must meet all qualifications to be eligible).

- You must be the owner or renter of the property and you must live at the property.
- If you are a renter, the owner must authorize your participation and agree to potential cost-sharing.
- You must be responsible for direct payment of your natural gas bill.
- Your total gross household income must fall below 300% of Federal Poverty Guidelines (chart is on application or can be found at [minnesotaenergyresources.com](http://minnesotaenergyresources.com)).
