



# Water heating rebates

After home heating, water heating is the second largest energy user in your home. Upgrading to an efficient water heater can reduce your natural gas use and help the environment. We recommend that you work with your contractor or retailer to select the water heater that will best fit your home's needs.

To apply for a rebate, download and fill out the **water heating rebate application**.

Funding is limited and can change or end at any time. Applications will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis.

## Rebates and minimum efficiency requirements

Measure	Minimum efficiency	Rebate
Natural gas water heater	0.62 EF* or 0.59 UEF**	\$45
Natural gas water heater	0.64 EF* or 0.62 UEF**	\$75
Natural gas water heater	0.67 EF* or 0.65 UEF**	\$125
Natural gas tank or tankless water heater	0.82 EF* or 0.81 UEF**	\$250
Natural gas tank or tankless water heater	0.90 EF* or 0.91 UEF**	\$300
Drain water heat recovery device (DHR)		\$150

Please reference all of the rebate requirements prior to installation in order to ensure eligibility.

\*\* UEF: Uniform Energy Factor
