



Low-Income Weatherization Assistance Program

Enjoy a more comfortable home and lower energy bills after energy-saving weatherization improvements. These services are **free for eligible homeowners and renters**.

Your energy bill can be a significant part of your household's budget. Minnesota Energy Resources is committed to making energy efficiency affordable and available for everyone. You may be eligible for funds dedicated to weatherizing low-income customers' homes. These small improvements can make a big difference in how much energy your home uses.

Minnesota Energy Resources provides funding to relevant Community Action Program (CAP) agencies for weatherization recruitment and installation. The measures installed at each home are based on the best fit for each particular home as assessed by the CAP agencies in an energy audit of your home. This is a no-cost program for eligible customers.

These improvements are funded by Minnesota Energy Resources:

- A standard energy audit
- Blower door test
- Air sealing
- Side wall insulation
- Attic insulation
- Tuck under garages, foundations, crawl spaces and rim joist insulation
- Proper venting of dryers and exhaust fans
- Caulking
- Weatherstripping
- Duct and pipe insulation in unfinished areas
- Emergency heating system and water-heating equipment replacement
- Post-installation inspections

Who is eligible?

Minnesota Energy Resources customers who use natural gas as a primary fuel for space heating and who also meet state and federal income guidelines.
